



**FINANCIAL COMPTROLLER

Background

The African Forum for Utility Regulators (AFUR) is an initiative established on the basis of Clause 110 of the Framework Document of the New Partnership for Africa's Development (NEPAD). AFUR's primary focus is on issues pertaining to the regulation of infrastructure (energy, communications, water and sanitation as well as transport sectors). Brief Description of Role

The AFUR Secretariat is seeking to appoint a Financial Comptroller (FC) who, reporting to the Executive Secretary will be part of the senior management team. The FC will provide strategic financial, budgeting and accounting, supply chain management, and administrative support services for the efficient operations of AFUR.
